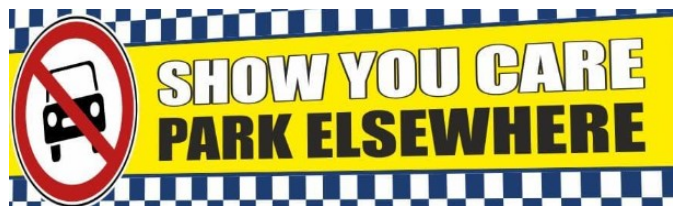
The Book Bus is visiting after school on Tuesday
